

Cardiology Clinic Information

What is included?

There are three cardiology packages available based on the needs of your pet.

1. *Initial Cardiac Assessment* – Consultation with cardiologist specialist, blood tests, echocardiogram (2D and Doppler studies), ECG, blood pressure and sedation if required.
2. *Cardiology Revisit Within 12-months* – Consultation with cardiologist specialist, echocardiogram (2D and Doppler studies), ECG, blood pressure and sedation if required.
3. *Urgent Cardiac Assessment* – Consultation with cardiologist specialist, blood tests, echocardiogram (2D and Doppler studies), 12-lead ECG, blood pressure, sedation if required and 24hr Holter ECG monitoring

What should I expect to happen on the day?

You will have been given a date and time to arrive at the clinic. Please check in at reception and you will be taken through as quickly as possible to have a consultation with Dr Michal Radawiec DMV GPCert(Cardio) MRCVS our cardiology specialist.

Following the consultation, you will be able to go about your day while Michal and our team take care of your pet. Our team will contact you to arrange a pick-up/discharge time after the assessment has been completed. This will normally be early afternoon.

On pickup you will have time to speak with Michal or a member of our team to discuss the findings and set out a plan for going forward.

What will happen after the clinic?

After the clinic Michal will put together a detailed report combining all the relevant details from the assessments and findings. A clinical report will be added to your pet's history to inform your regular vet of the results and decisions, and a client focused report will be provided to you along with an on-going care plan.
